

Instructions for wear checks of play equipment

The equipment must be checked for correct operation and safety, especially the points listed below:

Proof of maintenance

Date of installation

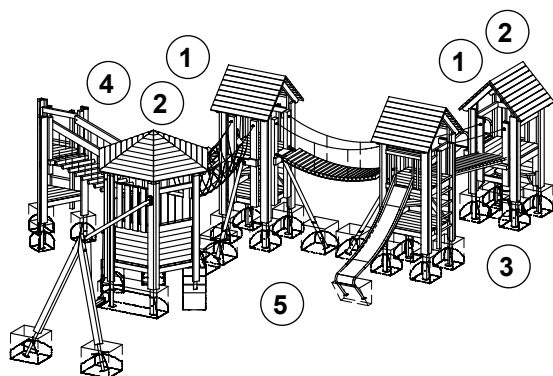
Equipment-specific inspections must be carried out at least twice a year.

Intervals for maintenance work and checks generally depend on

- the location
- the usage
- the frequency of use
- possible vandalism

Wooden parts

1. Check for rot and, if necessary, smooth out splinters and round off sharp edges of cracks.
2. Check that all bolts and screws are tight and retighten if necessary.
3. Check the ash wood rungs of the ladders for wear and tear, the remaining diameter must be at least 30 mm.
4. Recommendation: apply paraffin wax to the upper end grain areas once a year, please refer to Order No. 0.90100, 1 litre.

Structural stability

5. In order to check for rot at wooden parts and steel feet for corrosion, uncover the foundations once a year.
