
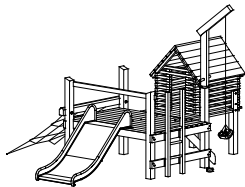

<h2 style="margin: 0;">Instructions for wear checks of play equipment</h2>	<p>The equipment must be checked for correct operation and safety, especially the points listed below:</p>	<p>Proof of maintenance</p>
<p>Playground</p> <p>Date of installation</p> <p>Checks depend on the type of equipment. Any equipment with moving parts must be checked at least twice a year, static equipment at least once a year.</p> <p>Intervals for maintenance work and checks generally depend on</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - location - kind of use - frequency of use - possible vandalism <p>For more details see also "General instructions for maintenance of playgrounds".</p> <p>Platform House Order No. 4.14914</p> 	<div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 10px;">Wooden parts</div> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Check for rot and, if necessary, smooth out splinters and round off sharp edges of cracks. <input type="checkbox"/> 2. Check that all bolts and screws are tight and retighten if necessary. <input type="checkbox"/> 3. Recommendation: apply paraffin wax to the upper end grain areas once a year, please refer to Order No. 0.90100, 1 litre. <input type="checkbox"/> 4. Check the ash wood rungs of the ladder for wear and tear, the remaining diameter must be at least 30 mm. <input type="checkbox"/> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 10px;">Inclined Climbing Net</div> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Check that connection points are tight and retighten if necessary. <input type="checkbox"/> 6. Check the climbing net for wear and tear, if the steel reinforcement is damaged it is imperative it be replaced. <input type="checkbox"/> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 10px;">Slide</div> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 7. Check the slide surface for vandalism. <input type="checkbox"/> 8. Check that all screws and bolts are tight, retighten if necessary. <input type="checkbox"/> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 10px;">Crane</div> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 9. Check all functional parts and retighten screws and bolts, if necessary. Check bearings/chains for wear and tear. <input type="checkbox"/> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 10px;">Structural stability</div> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 10. In order to check for rot at wooden parts or steel feet for corrosion, uncover the foundation once a year. <input type="checkbox"/> 11. Net: check the connection (tensioning hook) to the anchoring chain, if necessary re-tension the net at the bottom ends. <input type="checkbox"/> 	<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Special notes, e.g. for repairs</p>
